



Man of La Mancha & Dinner Thursday, May 6, 2010

A special benefit performance of "Man of La Mancha" will be held at the Actor's Guild of Parkersburg at 8PM. Prior to the show, Dinner will be served, at 6:30 p.m., at First Baptist Church.

Show Summary: In the sixteenth century, Miguel de Cervantes, a poet, playwright, and part-time actor, and his manservant have been arrested by the Spanish Inquisition. The two are accused of presenting entertainment offensive to the Inquisition. Inside the huge dungeon into which they have been cast, the other prisoners gang up on Cervantes and his manservant, and begin a mock trial, with the intention of stealing or burning his possessions. Cervantes wishes to desperately save a manuscript he carries with him. He stages (with costumes, makeup, and the participation of the other prisoners) an unusual defense -- the story of Don Quixote. This classic musical is one of musical theater's BEST.
